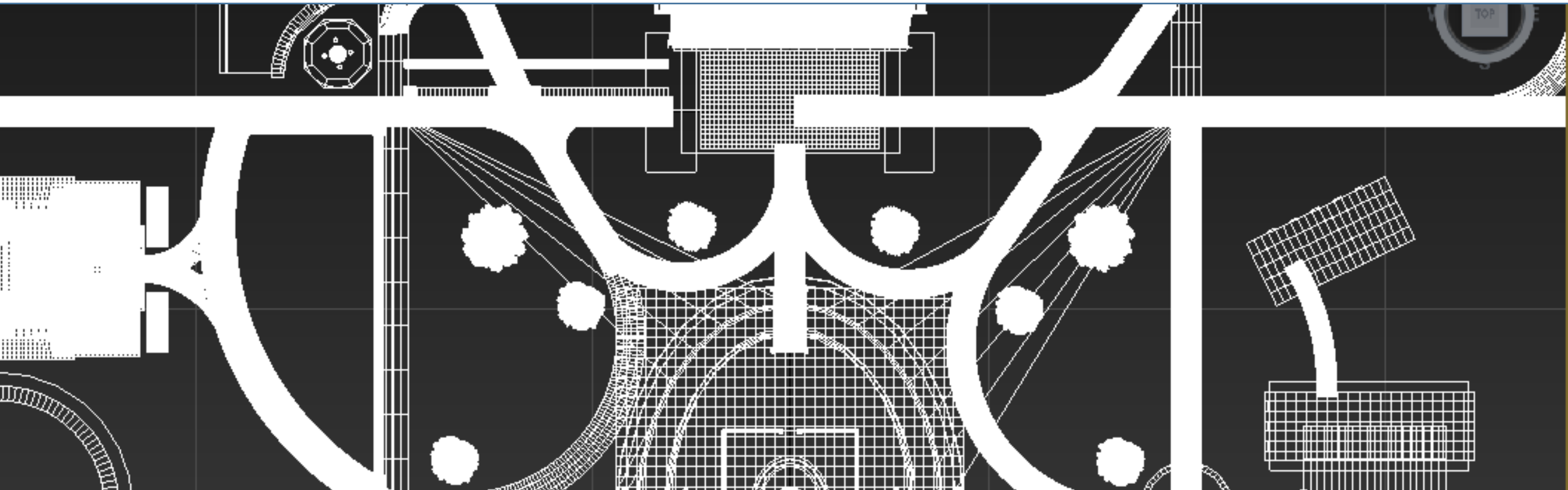

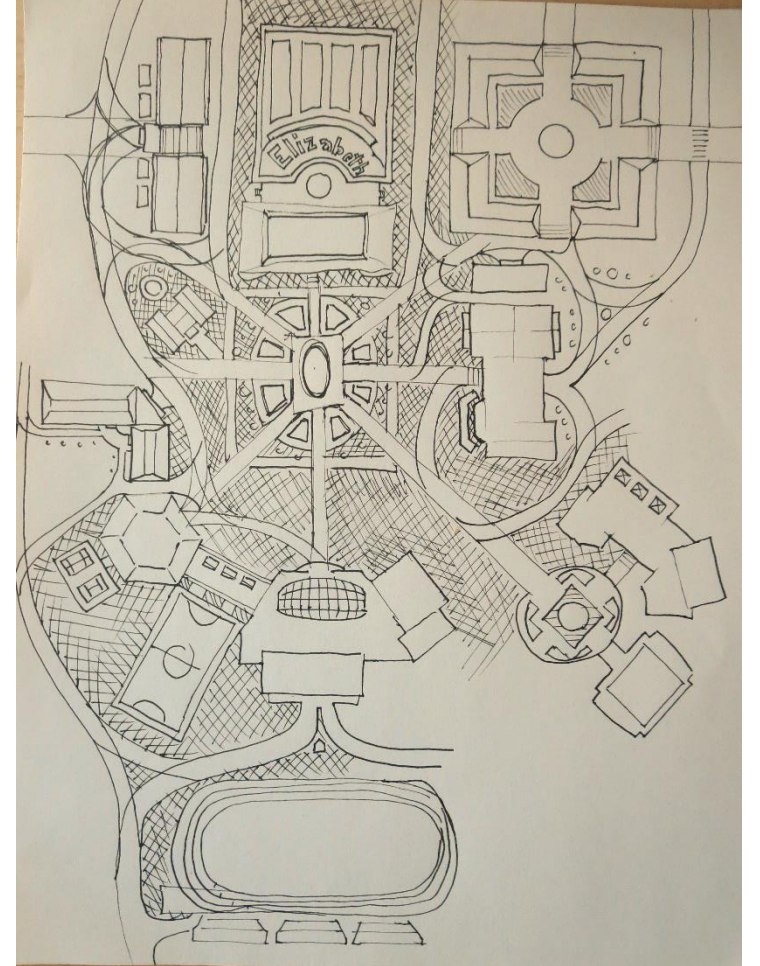


Project Goal

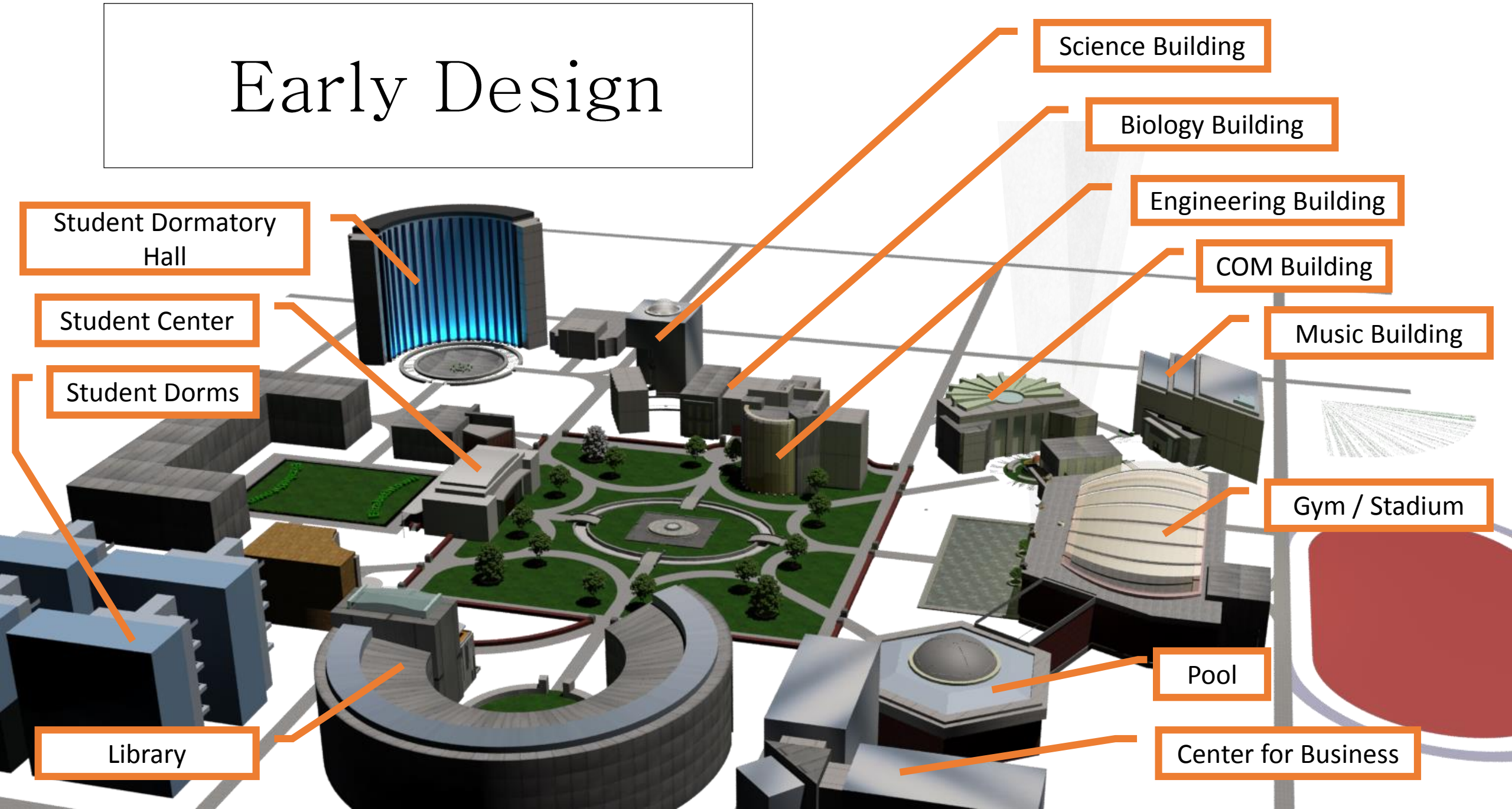

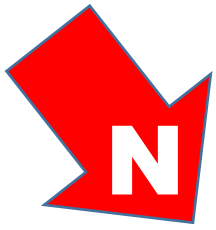
